- Development of Breast Rapid Access Program

 - allays fears of patients and providers
 - assumes responsibility and management if desired

Common breast conditions seen in consultation are mastodynia (breast pain), masses or concerns about masses, abnormal mammograms, nipple discharge, second opinion, high risk surveillance and follow-up treatment.
